## Special Notes

Special Notes: 1L Day Classes - The extra time built into the schedule can be used for make-up classes if necessary. Aviation Law (Clark, R.W.) will be held on the following four weekends: September 11 and 12; September 25 and 26; October 9 and 10; November 13 and 14. Each class session will begin at 10 AM and run approximately three hours. There will be no final examination. Grades will be on writing (which necessarily includes issue spotting), oral argument and class participation. Pretrial Advocacy (Finkelstein) - Pretrial Advocacy is a 4 credit course.
