#### ORDER OF THE COIF

The order of the Coif is an honorary scholastic society, the purpose of which is to encourage excellence in legal education by fostering a spirit of careful study, by recognizing those who as law students attained a high grade of scholarship, and by honoring those who as lawyers, judges and teachers attained high distinction for their scholarly or professional accomplishments. Of the 200 American law schools, only 21 have been granted a charter to establish a Coif Chapter. Rutgers Newark was the first New Jersey law school to establish a Coif chapter 26 years ago in 1991.

Individual membership in the Order of the Coif may be conferred upon graduates of member schools who rank at least in the top 10% of their class.

#### CENTER FOR GENDER AND SEXUALITY LAW AND POLICY (CGSLP) FELLOW

This fellowship provides a unique opportunity for a Rutgers Law student to work with the policy initiatives of the Center for Gender and Sexuality and Law and Policy.

#### CHILD ADVOCACY FELLOW

The Child Advocacy Fellowship is designed to encourage and support the training and development of students who wish to pursue careers in the public interest, and who are particularly committed to children's legal issues. The Child Advocacy Fellow enrolls in the Child Advocacy Clinic, and assists in the development of the Newark Education Advocacy and Access Project.

#### IMMIGRATION RIGHTS FELLOW

This fellow demonstrates a commitment to public service in the field of immigration law or immigration rights.

#### KINOY-STAVIS FELLOWS

This fellowship began in the name of one of its most nationally prominent and treasured faculty member, the late Professor Arthur Kinoy. It was later expanded in honor of the late Morton Stavis, co-founder with Professor Kinoy of the Center for Constitutional Rights and one of the nation's preeminent civil rights lawyers and former adjunct professor at the law school.

#### MARSHA WENK FELLOWS

Created in memory of Marsha Wenk, a 1987 graduate of the law school who dedicated her legal career to public service and who died in 1996, the Wenk fellowship program seeks to support students interested in developing a career in public interest law, and to foster a cadre of law students involved in public interest activities during law school.
