SeniorLAW Center is a non-profit legal services agency which seeks justice for older people by using the power of the law, educating the community and advocating on local, state and national levels.

4. Brief description of summer internship responsibilities and qualifications:

Each intern will be assigned to a project area and a supervisor in that designated project area. Program areas include Homeownership Rights, Tenants Rights, Grandparents Raising Grandchildren, and Victim Services. Interns assist with intake, client interviews, witness prep, shadowing lawyers at court (if certified by Supreme Court – they can take on a case under supervision to represent before the bar of the Court), research, at least one required writing assignment, attend project, legal team and staff meetings, participate in summer brown bag series from Philadelphia Bar association, and a final presentation to the Legal Team at end of internship.
