DL= Distance Learning:

Under current ABA guidance, all courses taught in the Holodeck (as well as asynchronous courses such as Patterson's UCC class) are considered distance learning. **This includes Holodeck courses where the professor is live, right in front of you**, but is also teaching students in the other location. A student may take up to 15 credits of distance learning while in law school. Our current Academic Rules limit DL credits to four per semester.
