**DL= Distance Learning:** Under current ABA guidance, all courses taught in the Holodeck are considered distance learning. **This includes Holodeck courses where the professor is live, right in front of you,** but is also teaching students in the other location. A student may take up to 15 credits of distance learning while in law school.

Courses taught in the Holodeck have either a room designation of 323HOLO-N (Newark-based course) or 323HOLO-C (Camden-based course).

#### EXCLUSIONS:

**Hunter Moot Court:** Students who take Hunter Moot Court may not also take Persuasion in Legal Writing. Students who have had Persuasion in Legal Writing may take Hunter Moot Court, but will earn only one (1) graded credit in the fall semester (and two credits in the spring semester).

**Room Locations:** Room numbers beginning with E are in the East building. Room E107 is the Moot Court Room. Room E107-A is the Jury Room.
