Under current ABA guidance, all courses taught in the Holodeck are considered distance learning. **This includes Holodeck courses where the professor is live, right in front of you**, but is also teaching students in the other location. A student may take up to 15 credits of distance learning while in law school. Our current Academic Rules limit DL credits to four per semester.

Courses taught in the Holodeck have either a room designation of 323HOLO-N (Newark-based course) or 323HOLO-C (Camden-based course).
