ADVISORY NOTICE: Rutgers law school publishes in advance a final examination schedule which is not subject to change **after the advance registration period is completed.** Courses are scheduled at the law school so that students may not select course loads with conflicting examinations (*i.e.*, exams which occur simultaneously). In addition, first-year examinations are scheduled to equalize the intervals between tests and, when possible, to provide a break between upperclass examinations. Students are urged not to construct a course load which produces unduly burdensome examination requirements. Rutgers School of Law-Camden does not grant deferments because a student has selected an over-taxing examination schedule.
